PETITION REQUEST: Establish a parking permit zone to limit and/or restrict parking on the 700 block of North Doheny Drive with a "1-Hour Parking, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., and No Parking, 6 p.m. to 2:00 a.m., Monday-Saturday, Except by Permit" regulation.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Include the 700 block of North Doheny Drive, within the Beverly Hills city limits, in Preferential Parking Permit Zone "O" with a consistent regulation as the 600 and 800 blocks of North Doheny Drive as follows:

**"2-Hour Parking, 8 a.m. to 7 p.m., Daily, and
No Parking, 7 p.m. to 2:30 a.m., Daily, Permit 'O' Exempt"**

PUBLIC COMMENT: Persons wishing to comment on this proposal are invited to attend the April 5, 2012 meeting. You may submit your comments in writing by e-mail, fax, or postal mail a minimum of 24-hours in advance of the meeting date to allow for routing and review by the Commission prior to the meeting.
